
Vacuum phenomenon

If an enclosed itsue space is allowed to expand as a rebound phenomenon after an external impact, the volume within the enclosed space will increase. In the setting of expanding volume, the pressure within the space will decrease. The solubiity of the gas in the enclosed space will decrease. The solubiity of the gas in the enclosed space will decrease as the pressure of the space decreases. Decreased solubility allows a gas to leave a solution. The combination of lower nitrogen solubility and the minimal metabolism of nitrogen by the body mainly accounts for the formation of the VP is the same as cavitation induced by rotation of a ship's propeller in water, which depends on two laws of physics: Henry's Law and Boyle's Law.


